A New Year, that for some may be filled with significant changes, a new job, a new school, the joy of welcoming a new life, a special occasion to plan a celebration for a, Birthday, Engagement or Wedding.

I am sure this year for me will continue to be filled with many new things, one of these will be the joy and privilege of meeting with couples who are planning to get married this year, then celebrating their love for each other by taking their wedding at St Mary's.

February is often considered to be the month when people's thoughts turn to love, on St Valentine's Day, we are reminded to cherish and nurture all the relationships that bring joy and love into our lives.



According to Hugh Grant in the film 'Love Actually', Love is.... 'all around', others might suggest, Love is.... having coffee with your best friend, Love is ... when a little hand finds yours, alongside Love is ... remembering memories of times spend together.

In the English language, there is only one word for Love, for which the dictionary definition, describes love an intense feeling of deep affection, or also a feeling of deep romantic attachment to someone, alongside a word used as an affectionate greeting given to another, and a way of describing a great pleasure or

interest in something.

Whilst the Greek language has eight different words to describe different attributes of love, some of these are, Philautia – self-love or self-esteem, Philia – affectionate love, a type of love that involves friendship, Storge – familial love or the natural love families may have for each other, Agape – unconditional or sacrificial love.

Agape is often defined as Christian love, in the New Testament 'Agape' is the word used to describe the love that God has for us and the love we should have for God. In John's gospel we read that 'For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life'. Agape describes the love Jesus felt for all of us,



which explains why he was prepared to sacrifice himself on the cross for us.



Through reading the Bible we find out more about the love of God and also how to find and develop a relationship with him. I would also like to take this opportunity to invite you to a 'Celebration of Love Service' at St Mary's on Sunday 16th February at 6pm where we are joining together to celebrate and give thanks for the many different aspects and attributes of love .

The children had a good break at Christmas and came back to school refreshed and ready for some super learning. I always think that we are lucky in schools as we get two fresh starts every year - September for the start of a new academic year and then January as the calendar year changes. We have focused on our 'ABC' Value of Belonging this term and I started of the year by sharing the story of Jesus and the Children from Mark 10.
